Idaho Governor Butch Otter

Our upcoming Business Leaders Forum will be held on Thursday, May 20, not Wednesday, May 19. We are very fortunate to have Idaho Governor, Butch Otter, as our speaker this month.

C.L. "Butch" Otter was elected Governor of Idaho on November 7, 2006. He previously served three terms in Congress representing Idaho's 1st District (2000-2006).

Governor Otter was born in Caldwell, Idaho. He graduated from St. Teresa's Academy in Boise, and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the College of Idaho in 1967.

Governor Otter's 30-year career in business included membership on the Board of Directors of the J.R. Simplot Company, director of the Food Products Division, President of Simplot Livestock, and President of Simplot International. He retired in 1993.

When he was elected to Congress, Governor Otter was serving his fourth term as Idaho's Lieutenant Governor. He had served in that office longer than anyone in Idaho's history, and was chairman of the Canyon County Republican Party.

On economic issues, Governor Otter supports broad based tax cuts including eliminating the estate and marriage tax. Governor Otter has supported small business associations to reduce health insurance costs via collaborative efforts. He has recommended an increase in Idaho state educational funding by \$1.36 billion as well as expanding needs-based scholarships for college-bound students.
